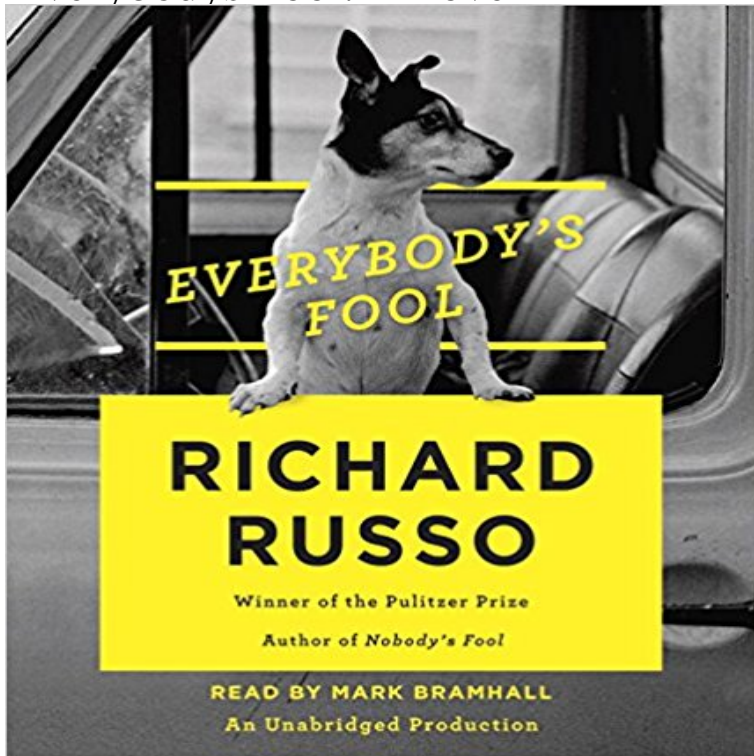


Everybodys Fool: A novel



Richard Russo, at the very top of his game, now returns to North Bath, in upstate New York, and the characters who made *Nobodys Fool* (1993) a confident, assured novel [that] sweeps the reader up, according to the *San Francisco Chronicle* back then. Simple as family love, yet nearly as complicated. Or, as *The Boston Globe* put it, a big, rambunctious novel with endless riffs and unstoppable human hopefulness. The irresistible Sully, who in the intervening years has come by some unexpected good fortune, is staring down a VA cardiologists estimate that he has only a year or two left, and its hard work trying to keep this news from the most important people in his life: Ruth, the married woman he carried on with for years . . . the ultra-hapless Rub Squeers, who worries that he and Sully arent still best friends . . . Sullys son and grandson, for whom he was mostly an absentee figure (and now a regretful one). We also enjoy the company of Doug Raymer, the chief of police whos obsessing primarily over the identity of the man his wife mightve been about to run off with, before dying in a freak accident . . . Baths mayor, the former academic Gus Moynihan, whose wife problems are, if anything, even more pressing . . . and then theres Carl Roebuck, whose lifelong run of failing upward might now come to ruin. And finally, theres Charice Bonda light at the end of the tunnel that is Chief Raymers officias well as her brother, Jerome, who might well be the train barreling into the station. *Everybody's Fool* is filled with humor, heart, hard times and people you cant help but love, possibly because their various faults make them so stridently human. This is classic Russo and a crowning achievement from one of the greatest storytellers of our time.
