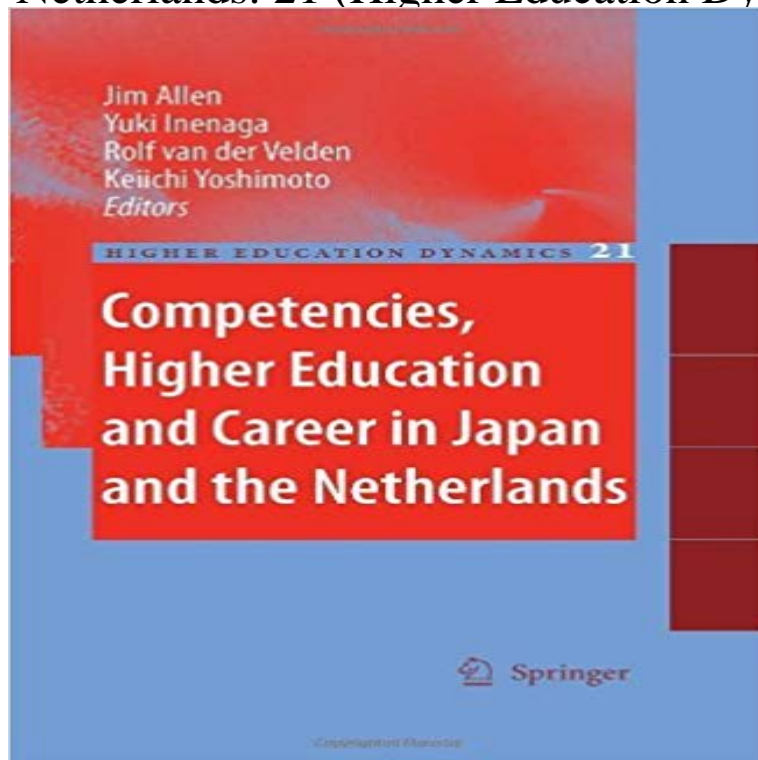


Competencies, Higher Education and Career in Japan and the Netherlands: 21 (Higher Education Dynamics)

The aim of this book is to explore how Dutch and Japanese graduates choose and develop their careers in reference to the above-mentioned challenges. It is based on a unique data set consisting of surveys held among graduates 3 and 8 years after leaving higher education.
