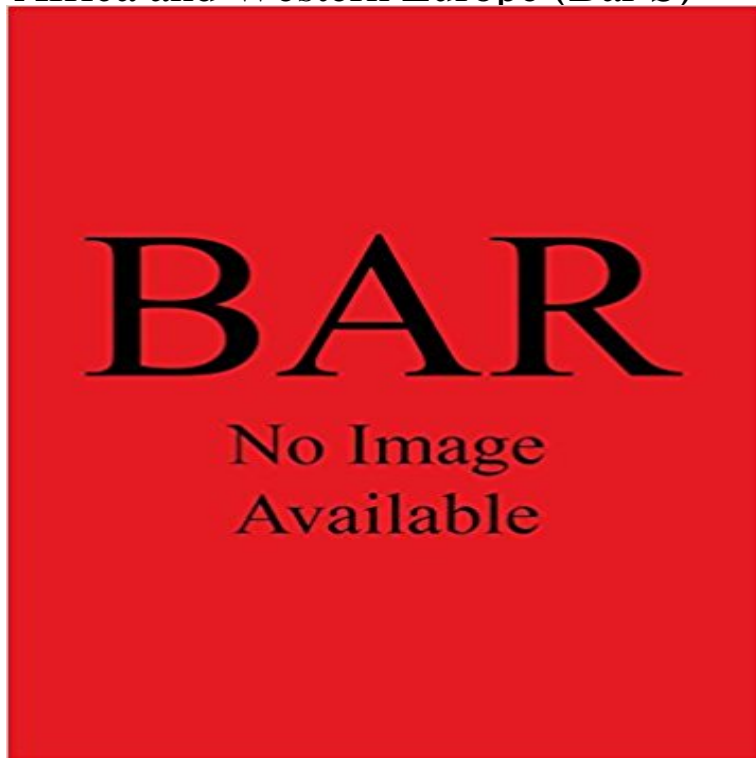


Comparison of the Late Pleistocene and Early Holocene Burials of North Africa and Western Europe (Bar S)
