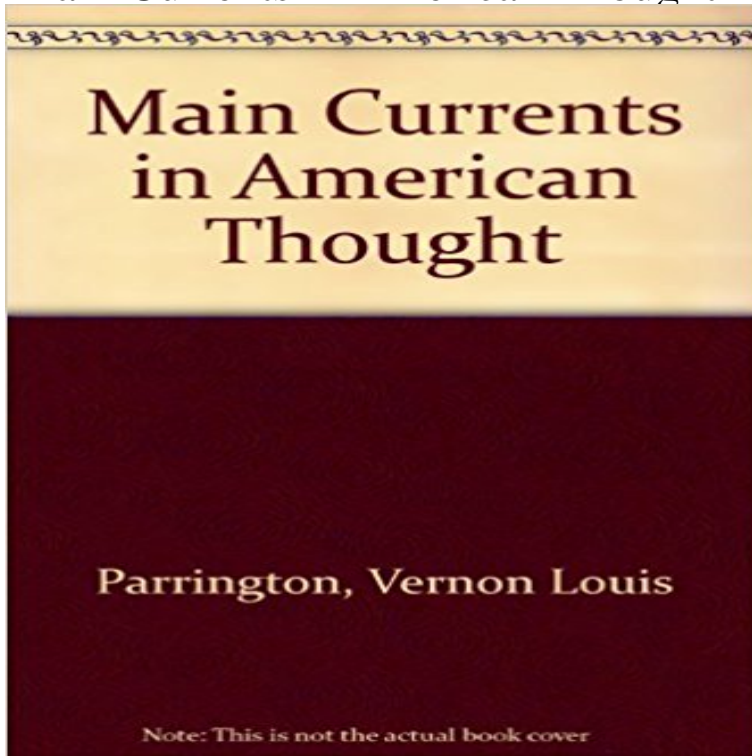


## Main Currents in American Thought
