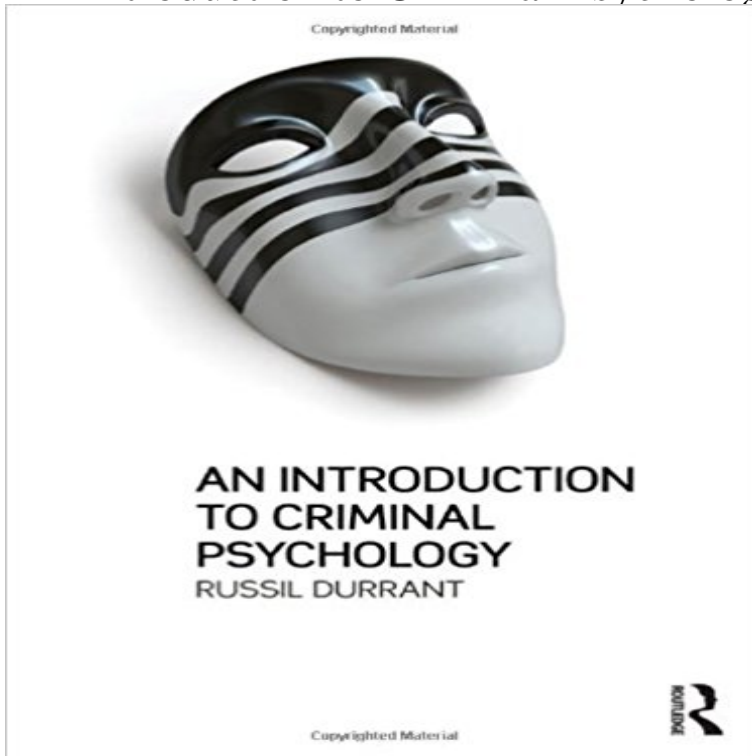


# An Introduction to Criminal Psychology
