The ramifications of Maos life and legacy are still very much felt today, as China continues to transition into a superpower that may soon lay claim to the worlds largest economy. Maos communist revolution is still controversial, but it was his reign over China that has made him notorious, and in the West he is often considered one of historys biggest tyrants. Maos revolution and his subsequent policies have been accused of causing millions of deaths, possibly more than the likes of Hitler and Stalin. It has been roughly estimated that Mao was responsible for the deaths of anywhere from 40-70 million, but he has plenty of defenders as well, who cite Maos military and political leadership for inspiring similar revolutions across the world.
