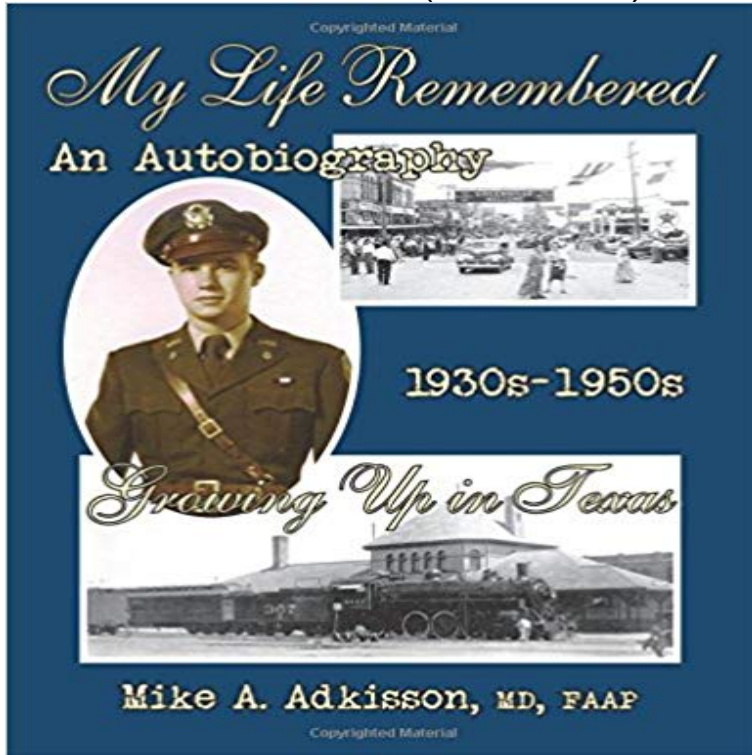


My Life Remembered, Volume I, an Autobiography :: Growing Up In Texas 1930s - 1950s (Volume 1)
